House bill, File No. 199, entitled "An Act to amend the charter of the Home of the Friendless, a corporation, carrying on beneficent work in Baltimore city, created under the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, 1852. chapter 231."

Whereas, said corporation, prior to the year 1859, increased the number of persons composing the Board of Government mentioned in its constitution or instrument of incorporation, but said amendment was not made known, acknowledged and recorded as directed by said Act, therefore, for the purpose of curing said omission and of further amending the charter of said corporation.
