House bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel County, to issue bonds for the purpose of funding the debt of said county, and to pay the current expenses thereof, and to levy a tax for the payment of the same,

House bill to authorize the refunding to the Merchants' and Traders' Banking Association of Baltimore City a sum of money.
