

50. To deed from Michael J. Curley to The Trustees of Towson Methodist Episcopal Church of Baltimore County and State of Maryland, a body corporate, dated March 11, 1946, and recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore County in Liber R. J. S. No. 1443, folio 77, containing 0.48 Acre of land—Ninth Election District of Baltimore County.

51. To deed from Amelia T. Rudigier, unmarried, to The Trustees of the Towson Methodist Episcopal Church of Baltimore County and State of Maryland, a body corporate, dated April 8, 1946, and recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore County in Liber R. J. S. No. 1448, folio 265, conveying a lot of ground immediately to the south of the present church structure fronting 93.8 ft. on the east side of the York Turnpike with a depth of 100.2 ft., more or less (irregular).

52. To deed from Emma J.
