

170. To bequests appearing in the Will of Lenore V. Wagner, which is recorded among the records in the office of Register of Wills in Baltimore City in Liber No. 221, folio 464:

(a) To bequest of \$1,000.00 to the Baltimore Goodwill Industries, Inc., a body corporate.

(b) To bequest of \$1,000.00 to the Board of Missions and Church Extension of the Methodist Church, a body corporate, with the request that it be used by its foreign division for work in China.

174. To Deed from Villa Nova Annex, Incorporated, to Pilgrim Evangelical Lutheran Church, of Baltimore, Maryland, dated January 21, 1947, and recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore County on January 23, 1947.

175. To the grant and assignment executed by Morris Glick and wife to The Mt.
