CHAPTER 482.

(Senate Bill 2)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 52 of Article 65 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Militia", eliminating the provision exempting honorary members of the Organized Militia from jury service and to repeal Section 711 of Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore City and Baltimore City Charter (1938 Edition), title "Baltimore City", sub-title "Jurors".

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 52 of Article 65 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Militia", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

52. Every member of the Organized Militia shall be exempt from jury duty, provided he shall present certificate of his
