134. To a bequest of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to the Home for Incurables of Baltimore, Maryland, contained in the Will of Anna Sophie Hellwig dated March 22nd, 1929, and recorded among the records of the Register of Wills for Baltimore City.

135. To a bequest of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) to the Strawbridge Methodist Church of Baltimore and a bequest of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000) to the Home for the Aged of the Methodist Episcopal Church, contained in the Will of Mary Hetzell, dated January 9th, 1935, and recorded among the records of the Register of Wills for Baltimore City.
