No. 11. An Act authorizing the County Commissioners of Garrett county to levy money for the payment of wolf, or other scalps, destroyed within the limits of said county.

No. 12. An Act to repeal Article 31, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Crows," so far as the same relates to Harford, Frederick, Montgomery, Queen Ann's, Calvert, Prince George's, Garrett, Talbot, Charles, Carroll and Caroline counties.

No. 13. An Act to regulate the pay of the State's Attorney for Cecil county.
