Mr. Waters, of Dor., moved to add to Section 2, "two thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated for the purpose of purchasing the interest of the stockholders in the Maryland Agricultural College, to be expended by the Governor, Comptroller and Treasurer."
