Wills 24, Liber D.D. No. 3, p. 1-551, 1744-1746. P. 1-50, 50A, 487-551 are handwritten copies, probably made in 1834. There is also a photostat copy.

Wills 25, Liber D.D. No. 4, p. 1-578, 1746-1748. A transcription probably made in 1834. P. 1-4 appear to be even more recent transcriptions, probably made in 1874. P. 578 ends in the middle of a will, indicating that one or more leaves have been lost at the end of the book.

Wills 26, Liber D.D. No. 5, p. 1-148, 1748-1749. P. 1-2, 19-20, 75-76 are handwritten copies, probably made in 1874. There are two photostat copies, only one of which is bound.

Wills 27, Liber D.D. No. 6, p. 1-541, 1749-1750. P. 1-16, 538-541 are copies probably made in 1834. Also a positive photostat copy.

Wills 28, Liber D.D. No. 7, p. 1-562, 1751-1754. P. 1-16, 465-469, 484-485 are copies, probably made in 1874 or later. There is also a handwritten copy made in 1910.

Wills 29, Liber B.T. No. 1, p. 1-562, 1753-1755. P. 1-32, 559-562 are handwritten copies, probably made in 1834.

Wills 30, Liber B.T. No. 2, two volumes: part 1—p. 1-466, part 2—467-864, 1755-1760. A transcription, probably made in 1834. P. 265-434 are all that remain of the original.

Wills 31, Liber D.D. No. 1, two volumes: part 1—p. 1-592, part 2—p. 593-1132, 1760-1764. The page numbers now used represent a corrected pagination; the original numbers ran as follows:
p. 1-592=p. 3-335, 335-512, 613-693.

p. 593-1097=p. 694-721, 721-787, 787-879, 890-1064, 1067-1160, 1160-1193, 1193-1196, 1196-1205.

p. 1098—blank.

p. 1099-1132=p. 1-34, the arrangement of the entries in the old general index to wills indicates that this section was formerly located in the front of the liber, where chronologically it belongs.

Wills 32, Liber S.B. No. 1, p. 1-342, 1764. Also a photostat copy.

Wills 33, Liber C.G. No. 1, p. 1-434, 1764-1765. The pagination has been corrected.
