- Liber 29**—*Rent Roll Dorchester and Caroline No. 1.* 357 pages; typed index of tract names:
- (1) Additional annual rent rolls for Dorchester County between 1733 and 1764 (pp. 1-349); alienations to 1772.
 - (2) Caroline County (pp. 350-357); record of lands patented 1782-1790.
- Liber 30**—*Rent Roll Dorchester No. 2.* 90 pages; typed index of tract names; contains additional rent rolls for Dorchester County from 1733 to 1746, comprising the first fourteen of the thirty-two additional rent rolls found in Liber 29; alienations to 1746.
- Liber 31**—*Rent Roll Dorchester No. 3.* 173 pages; typed index of tract names; contains additional rent rolls from 1764 to 1775 (pp. 1-159) and names, owners and acreages of lands patented between 1782 and 1790 (pp. 160-173); alienations to 1772.
- Liber 32**—*Rent Roll Frederick No. 1.* 234 pages; typed index of tract names; entries on lands patented to 1751; alienations to 1775.
- Liber 33**—*Rent Roll Frederick No. 2.* 80 pages; typed index of tract names; entries on lands patented to 1751 plus (pp. 81-103) names, owners and acreages of lands patented 1782-1790; alienations to 1770; original index. This is the Revenue Office counterpart of Liber 32, pp. 1-80.
- Liber 34**—*Rent Roll Frederick No. 3.* 179 pages; typed index of tract names; original index; entries on lands patented to 1759; alienations to 1775.
- Liber 35**—*Rent Roll Frederick No. 4.* Photostat of original; 271 pages; entries on lands patented to 1767; alienations to 1775; typed index of tract names; original has an index, not included in photostat copy.
- Liber 36**—*Rent Roll Frederick No. 5.* 241 pages; typed index of tract names; entries on lands patented to 1775 plus names, owners and acreages of lands patented 1783-1790; alienations to 1775.
