- Liber 14**—*Debt Books 1757-61 Charles County.* Five books bound together, containing entries as above. The debt books for 1757 and 1758 each have 87 pages; 1759 has 60 pages; 1760 has 52 pages and part of an index; 1761 has 53 pages. No alphabetical arrangement.
- Liber 15**—*Debt Books 1762-66 Charles County.* Five books bound together, each containing entries as above. The debt book for 1762 has 52 pages; 1763 has 54 pages; 1764 and 1765 each have 57 pages; 1766 has 60 pages. No alphabetical arrangement.
- Liber 16**—*Debt Books 1767-71 Charles County.* Five books bound together, each containing entries as above. The debt book for 1767 has 60 pages, for 1768, 40 pages, for 1769, 41 pages, for 1770, 77 pages and for 1771, 55 pages. No alphabetical arrangement.
