

disbursed by him or them, and shall file an accurate statement of such account, with vouchers, with the County Commissioners at regular intervals of three months from the date of his or their appointment, and at such other time or times as the County Commissioners shall require, and such account shall be subject to the approval and ratification of the County Commissioners.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

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**Chapter 173.**

AN ACT to add additional sections to the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Cecil County," sub-title "County Commissioners," providing for the collection of taxes in Cecil county, as follows:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the following sections be and the same are hereby added to the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Cecil County," sub-title "County Commissioners," to read as follows:

Additional sections.

SECTION 61. There shall be in each election district of Cecil county a collector of State and county taxes, who shall be appointed by the County Commissioners on or before the second Tuesday in April of each year. He shall execute to the State of Maryland, on or before the second Tuesday of May succeeding his appointment, a good and sufficient bond, to be approved by the County Commissioners, in a sum double the amount of State tax that will be entrusted to him for collection; and in like manner, on or before the second Tuesday of June, in the same year, another bond to the State of Maryland, to be also approved by the County Commissioners, in a sum double the amount of county tax that will be entrusted to him for collection; and
