

eighteen hundred and eighty-one, filed and remaining in the office of the Register of Wills for Frederick county, bequeath and devise to "The Memorial Evangelical Lutheran Church of Washington, in the District of Columbia," the sum of one thousand dollars; to "The Board of Home Missions of the General Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of the United States," one-half of the proceeds of the sale of his railroad stock and bonds, and to "The Evangelical Lutheran Church of Frederick," the other half of the proceeds of the sale of his railroad stock and bonds, and all the rest and residue of his estate, real and personal, not otherwise devised and bequeathed by him; therefore—

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That its sanction is hereby declared and given to the aforesaid legacies contained in the last will and testament of the said Alexius E. Smith, late of Frederick county, deceased.

### Chapter 260.

AN ACT to amend the second sub-section of the act passed at January session, eighteen hundred and eighty, chapter one hundred and twenty-two, by adding thereto an additional sub-section relating to the valuation and assessment of certain public securities, to be known as sub-section 2 A.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the second sub-section of the act passed at January session, eighteen hundred and eighty, chapter one hundred and twenty-two, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following additional sub-section, to be known as sub-section 2 A.

SUB-SEC. 2 A. All certificates of indebtedness or evidences of debts in whatever form, made or issued by any State, territory, county, public corporation or foreign country, shall be subject to valuation and
