

for the fourth election district, three justices of the peace (one of whom shall reside in Rockville) and three constables (one of whom shall reside in Rockville); for the fifth election district, four justices of the peace and three constables; for the sixth election district, two justices of the peace and two constables; for the seventh election district, two justices of the peace and two constables; for the eighth election district, three justices of the peace (one of whom shall reside at Sandy Spring) and two constables; for the ninth election district, two justices of the peace and two constables; for the tenth election district, two justices of the peace and two constables; for the eleventh election district, two justices of the peace and two constables.

Number of constables.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That all acts or parts of acts which are inconsistent with this act be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of said inconsistency.

Inconsistent acts repealed.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

**Chapter 389.**

AN ACT to facilitate the examination of titles to land in Howard county, by authorizing the clerk of the Circuit Court for said county to make out general indexes to the law and equity dockets in his office, and to provide for paying for the same.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the clerk of the Circuit Court for Howard county be and he is hereby authorized and required to make out, in a fair and legible handwriting, general indexes to the law and equity dockets in his office, from the beginning of said dockets to the passage of this act, and shall be allowed therefor the same compensation as is
