

such liquor required as a medicine; any one violating the provisions of this act shall, on conviction, be fined not less than fifty dollars nor more than three hundred dollars for each and every offence, and be committed until fine and costs are paid; and provided further that this act shall not prevent the manufacture of cider from fruit of any kind, by the grower of such fruit, or the sale of the same in quantities over ten gallons.

Penalty for violation.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 468.

AN ACT to repeal chapter four hundred and twenty-five of the acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An act for the better protection of Fish in the waters of Frederick and Carroll counties," and to enact the following in lieu thereof:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That chapter four hundred and twenty-five of the acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An act for the better protection of fish in the waters of Frederick and Carroll counties." be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following is enacted in lieu thereof:

Repealed and enacted in lieu

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to take, catch or destroy any fish in any manner hereafter during the month of May in the waters of Frederick or Carroll counties; provided the Potomac river shall be exempted from the provisions of this act.

When unlawful.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That any person or persons violating the provisions of the preceding section shall, upon conviction before any justice of the peace of said counties, be liable to a fine of not less than five nor more than ten dollars for each
