

remaining parts of this Act or any section thereof, if it had known such clause, sentence, part or parts or any section thereof should be declared unconstitutional.

SEC. 28. REPEAL. *And be it further enacted*, That, except as otherwise provided herein, all Acts and parts of Acts, laws and parts of laws, ordinances and parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith or contrary hereto, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency, provided, however, that Chapter 705 of the Acts of 1927 and all laws and ordinances passed pursuant thereto shall not be affected hereby, and that this Act shall be deemed to be in addition to said Chapter 705 of the Acts of 1927 and not in substitution therefor.

SEC. 29. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect May 1, 1933.

#### CHAPTER 600.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1929 Supplement), title "Licenses," sub-title "Motor Vehicles," sub-heading "Fees for Registration of Motor Vehicles," said new section to be known as Section 183A, to follow immediately after Section 183 of said Article, to authorize and direct the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles to refuse to issue any marker, certificate of registration or title to any motor vehicle whose owner resides within the corporate limits of the City of Westminster, Carroll County, City of Easton, Talbot County, Maryland, unless all municipal taxes due and in arrears thereon have been paid and to provide separate assessments and tax bills for motor vehicles.
