

1 DR. LOEVY: That is really two classifications.
2 I was just wondering if Dean Fordham thought if we stayed
3 with this idea of the status quo, just having those two
4 classifications would provide enough latitude for the
5 Legislature.

6 MR. MILES: How do we give all counties this
7 broad grant of power?

8 DR. LOEVY: This was one of Dean Fordham's
9 suggestions.

10 MR. MILES: I think they should, but how?

11 DR. LOEVY: The Legislature could pass an express
12 powers act.

13 DEAN FORDHAM: You could do it in Ohio fashion,
14 which applies to cities and villages. Give substantive
15 powers directly by constitution and leave the matter of
16 adopting home rule charter to local option.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Wouldn't the answer to Mr. Miles'
18 question be they can adopt a form of charter or code for
19 themselves under one or the other of the two classifications
20 or, failing to do so, the Legislature would then require
21 them to take, and it will have to provide either the charter
