1 JUDGE ADKINS: Fine. Well, we have provided you with a list of questions of matters that are under 2 consideration by our Committee, and I think we would be 3 happy to have you comment on any or all of those questions 4 that you feel you would like to comment on. We are, for 5 example, interested in whether or not you feel that the б 7 two-term limitation should be continued. GOVERNOR TAWES: Yes. Well, my answer to that 8 9 would be Yes. I think the two consecutive term limita-10 tion should be continued. I think four years is too lit-11 tle, too short a time for a governor to properly put 12 through his entire program that he anticipates putting 13 through when he assumes office. Many states throughout the nation have two-year 14 15 terms with no limit to the number of terms a governor may 16 succeed himself.
