I feel perfectly all right, but my voice is none too 1 good and I feel that it would be best for me to finish, 2 if you will let me talk, and I can leave you. I would 3 like to use this as the basis of a written report that I should like to make to the Commission. I don't think 5 I am presumptious because in the letter that Mr. Brooks 6 sent, he suggested that we do just that and, with your 7 permission, I will make it as brief as I can and I will B file a written report later. 9 I think, from the standpoint of education, we

> are very much concerned as to the reason for the change in the Constitution. I am not objecting, Mrs. Chairman, Mr. Eney, at all to this. I think it is always wise to review this, but I think that we should put our purpose in the light, before the people, so we know exactly what we are trying to get at. I think there are three problems.

housekeeping. Now, if the purpose of revising the Constitution is simply to tidy things up, then I think we're wasting time. Another thing, I think it is very destructive, for this reason. So many court decisions
