all the Constitution should say, but I'm not suggesting that you take out the words thorough and efficient. I noted from Dr. Bard's model of the Constitution wording that might perhaps be better.

Now, you asked me to comment about the safeguards which have to do with keeping the public school funds inviolate. I think Dr. Pullen has given you good examples as to why that should be kept that way, so that the budget could not be amended and amended away from the public school funds which rightfully belong to the schools.

Now, I think this should be said. This section applies to the mandated sections of the law, sections which are mandated by law. This doesn't protect the funds of the State Department of Education. They can be reduced by the legislature. It protects the mandated sections which require, for instance, salaries for teachers and the other things which must be paid to run a school system.

I think this is the section which we should not permit to be -- I would suggest that we do not change
