

1 DELEGATE EMANUEL: I am the vice-chairman of
2 the committee on local legislation, a subcommittee of
3 the Legislative Council, and I was made vice-chairman
4 presumably because I introduced legislation some time
5 ago to do what I am talking about, and I think in the
6 creation of a Constitution we should very carefully look
7 at that.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: We welcome your comments, Mr.
9 Emanuel. You should know that the Legislative Department
10 Committee has not taken any position on Question 1. Just
11 a few moments ago you referred to the fact that we had
12 some documents in reference to Item 1. This is true.
13 We have a number of documents in reference to both posi-
14 tions vis-a-vis unicameral or bicameral, and we are very
15 happy that you have commented on that idea.

16 Are there any members of the Commission itself
17 who want to branch off into the point that -- we might
18 take a moment or two to deal with that, if you want to.

19 MR. ENEY: I think it would be better if we
20 go right on.
