2 MR. ENEY: Joe, I'm not quite sure I follow  
3 you and I think that is an important point. You mean by  
4 retaining the Senate, you get a different kind of repre-  
5 sentation that would give a little more say-so to the  
6 less populous counties? Is that what you're hitting at?

7 SENATOR CURRAN: This is one way of doing it.  
8 I would hate to think that we would do away with area  
9 representation and strictly go on the populous areas.  
10 I think the retention of the Senate would in some way  
11 insure, to a degree, to the areas that are not perhaps  
12 as rapidly growing at least some semblance of a say in  
13 the one thing that most concerns them and that is the  
14 distribution of revenues.

15 MR. ENEY: In other words, if I follow you,  
16 what you are saying is you would prefer to retain the  
17 Senate because of the same reason you have it now, but  
18 in a lesser degree?

19 SENATOR CURRAN: Well, it's another shot at  
20 the problem. That may not be the only reason, but that  
21 is my one reason the idea of home rule is not good,
