

1 THE CHAIRMAN: No, that could be done in either  
2 way. Well, any other questions on this general subject?

3 MR. BOND: Not on education.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Does anyone have anything?

5 DR. JENKINS: Yes, I have a question.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Go ahead, Dr. Jenkins, and then  
7 we will go on to something else.

8 DR. JENKINS: I know, Mr. Rennie, I am sort of  
9 anticipating the reply, but I will ask the question anyway.  
10 The University presently has a certain amount of fiscal  
11 autonomy by statute and in some States this fiscal  
12 autonomy of an institution of a higher education is provided  
13 in the Constitution. Would you give us your views on that?

14 THE CHAIRMAN: I am glad you asked that, Dr.  
15 Jenkins, and not me.

16 MR. RENNIE: I can only reiterate what my stand  
17 on this is from the time that the University of Maryland  
18 got its autonomy. I was against it then, I thought it was  
19 wrong, and I still think it is wrong for them to have it  
20 and I think it is wrong for any State agency to have complete  
21 autonomy, outside of either the legislative -- well, this
