the association, or upon the lots and improvements thereon, within the camp-ground limits, and enforce the collection of the same for the purpose of meeting the legitimate camp-meeting expenses of the association, and improving and keeping the grounds in order.

Trustees.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That the stockholders of the said corporation at the annual meeting which shall be held on the grounds of the association on the second Monday of May of each year, or at such other time as may be fixed by said association, shall elect a board of twenty-five trustees, who shall be shareholders in said association, to manage the affairs of said association according to the rules and by-laws of the association, and any adjourned or called meeting of said association may be held in the District of Columbia; provided, that at least five days' notice of any called meeting shall be previously given or mailed to the stockholders of the association.

Police duties

SEC. 6 A. *And be it enacted*, That the Sheriff of the county in which said camp-ground is located, upon the application of the board of trustees of said association, shall have power to appoint such peace officers as they may deem necessary, for the purpose of preserving order on the camp-grounds and premises of said corporation, which officers shall be paid by said corporation for their services, and shall have when on duty the same power, authority and immunities which county Constables and other peace officers under the laws of this State possess and enjoy when on duty as such, and they shall have power to enforce obedience on said grounds and premises to any rules or regulations of said board of trustees or of said association for the preservation of quiet and good order, and the suppression of drunkenness on said grounds and premises.

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
