

cision of said Justice may appeal to the Circuit Court of said county, and have said charge tried before a Jury.

Arrest.

SEC. 8. It shall be the duty of the Constables of the several election districts of the county, to arrest all persons who they may have good reason to believe are guilty of violating any of the provisions of this act, and take them before a Magistrate for trial or hearing, as provided in this act, and any Constable failing to perform his duty herein as aforesaid, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on indictment and conviction shall be subject to such penalty as the Court may impose.

Effective.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 245.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the County School Commissioners of Prince George's county to appropriate the sum of five hundred dollars, for the purpose of building a School House for white children, at or near Melwood, in said county.

Appropriation
for Schools.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County School Commissioners of Prince George's county be and they are hereby authorized and directed to appropriate the sum of five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, out of the fund for the support of white schools for Prince George's county, for the purpose of building a School House for white children at or within a half mile limit of Melwood, in the said county.
