

chapter four hundred of the acts of eighteen hundred and eight-two, relating to shooting wild fowl in the waters of South river, in Anne Arundel county, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Repealed.

SEC. 6. That one-half of all fines imposed and collected under this act shall be paid to the informer, and the other half, together with the money arising from licenses, shall be paid to the School Commissioners of said county, for the benefit of the Public Schools thereof.

Fines.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That all licenses issued under this act shall begin on the first day of May in each and every year and continue only for one year from the date thereof, and no person shall be allowed to license more than one blind in any season; and if more than one license is so obtained by any person, the same shall be revoked by the said Clerk, but the money paid therefor shall not be recovered, but shall be disposed of the same as if the license was legally issued.

CHAPTER 338.

AN ACT to repeal sections one hundred and thirty-one, one hundred and thirty-two and one hundred and thirty-three of article three, Public Local Laws of Baltimore county, and re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sections one hundred and thirty one, one hundred and thirty-two and one hundred and thirty-three of article three, Public Local Laws of Baltimore county, be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows:
