

tion be added to article forty-four of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Hospital, Maryland," to be known as Section A, and to read as follows:

Additional Sections added.

SEC. A. The Board of Managers of the Maryland Hospital shall appoint two or more students, who shall be residents in the Maryland Hospital, for the purpose of studying the subject of insanity, said students shall be provided with quarters as other officers or employees; that said students shall be graduates of some legally authorized Medical College, and shall be appointed for one year and shall pay the sum of two hundred dollars per annum each for their board and washing; said students so appointed, shall be required to do such medical duties as the Board of Managers and Superintendent may require of them, or they may be summarily dismissed by the Board of Managers for neglect of duty or other cause, which in their judgment may be sufficient to justify such dismissal.

Appoint Students.

## CHAPTER 340.

AN ACT to repeal sections sixty-one, sixty-two, sixty-three, sixty-four, sixty-five, sixty-six, sixty-seven, sixty-eight, sixty-nine, seventy, seventy-one, seventy-two and seventy-three of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Cecil County," sub-title "County Commissioners," as enacted by the act of eighteen hundred and eighty-two, chapter one hundred and seventy-three, and enact the following sections in lieu thereof:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections sixty-one,
