

CHAPTER 45.

AN ACT to repeal section thirty-six of article fifty-one of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Justices of the Peace," sub-title "Civil Jurisdiction," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section thirty-six of article fifty-one of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Justices of the Peace," sub-title "Civil Jurisdiction," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows :

SECTION 36. Before issuing a writ of replevin the Justice shall require and take from the party demanding such writ, a bond to the party holding such property, with one or more securities, who shall make oath before the said Justice, that he or they are worth each double the value of the specific article or articles of property intended to be replevied, over and above all debts and exemptions, and whom the said Justice shall in his conscience believe to be so worth, with condition that if the above bound ——— do and shall well and truly prosecute the said writ of replevin with effect, and also shall and will return the goods and chattels aforesaid, if the same be adjudged, and in all things abide by and perform the judgment of the said Justice, or of such other Justice of the Peace, in and for said county, as shall decide in the premises, then the said obligation to be void, else to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
