CHAPTER 437.

AN ACT to add a sub-section to section four of an act entitled an act to repeal sections four and eight of an act to exempt all that portion of the waters of the Chesapeake bay therein described from the effect and operation of section one and three of article ninety-eight of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Wild Fowl," passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two chapter fifty-four, and to re-enact the said sections four and eight with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the following subsection, to be known and designated as sub-section four A, be added to section four of an act entitled an act to repeal sections four and eight of an act entitled an act to exempt all that portion of the Chesapeake bay therein described from the effect and operation of sections one and three of article ninety-eight of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Wild Fowl," passed at the January session eighteen hun-
