

CALVERT, CECILIUS, 2ND LORD BALTIMORE (1605–1675). **FAMILY BACKGROUND.** MOTHER: Anne: Delete “(1579–1622).” Add “(1578–1621).” SISTERS: Grace: Delete “(1614–?).” Add “(1611–1672).” Sir Robert Talbot: Add “(ca. 1610–1670).” Helen: Delete “(1615–1655).” Add “(ca. 1615–1655).” **CHILDREN. SONS:** *Charles Calvert, 3rd Lord Baltimore* (1637–1714/15) married second, Jane: Delete “(?–1700).” Add “(?–1700/1).”

CALVERT, CECILIUS (1667–1681). **FAMILY BACKGROUND.** MOTHER: Jane Lowe Sewall: Delete “(?–1700).” Add “(?–1700/1).”

CALVERT, CHARLES, 3RD LORD BALTIMORE (1637–1714/15). **MARRIED** second, Jane: Delete “(?–1700).” Add “(?–1700/1).” **CHILDREN. SONS:** Delete “and Charles (1680–1733).” **STEPDAUGHTERS:** Elizabeth Sewall: Add “(?–ca. 1710).”

CALVERT, LEONARD (ca. 1606–1647). **FAMILY BACKGROUND.** MOTHER: Anne: Delete “(1579–1622).” Add “(1578–1621).” SISTERS: Grace: Delete “(1614–?).” Add “(1611–1672).” Helen: Delete “(1615–1655).” Add “(ca. 1615–1655).”

CALVERT, PHILIP (1626–1682). **FAMILY BACKGROUND.** HALF SISTERS: Grace: Delete “(1614–?).” Add “(1611–1672).” **MARRIED** second, Jane, daughter of Jane Lowe: Add “(?–1700/1).” Her sister was Elizabeth: Add “(?–ca. 1710).”

CALVERT, WILLIAM (ca. 1642/43–1682). **MARRIED** Elizabeth’s brothers were: Delete “Charles.” Add “Matthew (?–1676).” Richard: Delete “(?–1767).” Add “(?–1667).”

CAMPBELL, WALTER (1665–1738). **PRIVATE CAREER. EDUCATION:** Delete “illiterate.” Add “literate.”

CARROLL, HENRY JAMES (ca. 1767–ca. 1814). **MARRIED** Elizabeth: Delete “granddaughter of *Robert King* (1689–1755)” and all following relatives. Add “She was the great-granddaughter of *Robert King* (1689–1755).” **PUBLIC CAREER.** Add “OUT OF STATE SERVICE: presidential elector, 1808.”

CARVILLE, JOHN (ca. 1670–1709). **FAMILY BACKGROUND.** Add “STEPMOTHER: Susanna Ayres. HALF SISTER: possibly Mary Carville (?–1718), who

married in 1710 *Roger Matthews* (ca. 1685–1740).” **MARRIED** by 1689 Mary (?–1738), daughter of James Phillips: Add “(?–1689)” and wife Susannah: Add “(?–1708/9).” Delete “She subsequently married by 1718 Richard Smithers.” Add “Mary was the stepdaughter of both Mark Richardson and Benjamin Arnold (Arnall). Her nephews were *Aquila Paca* (ca. 1703–1743/44); *John Paca* (ca. 1712–1785). Mary Phillips Carville subsequently married by 1718 Richard Smithers (?–1731).”

CARY, JOHN DOW (?–?). **FAMILY BACKGROUND.** MOTHER: Mary: Add “daughter of William Beatty.” **WEALTH DURING LIFETIME. SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN LAND BETWEEN FIRST ELECTION AND DEATH:** Delete “Jacob Young.” Add “*Jacob Young* (?–1805).”

CASWELL, RICHARD (1685–1755). **MARRIED** Christian Dallam’s stepfather was William Smith, Gent.: Delete “(?–1731).” Add “(?–1731/32).”

CHANDLER, JOB (?–1659). **CHILDREN SONS:** Richard (1651–1697): Add “married Elizabeth Hamilton Burdett.”

CHAPMAN, HENRY HENLEY (?–1821). **PUBLIC CAREER.** Add “OUT OF STATE SERVICE: presidential elector, 1812.”

CHASE, JEREMIAH TOWNLY (1748–1828). **MARRIED** Hester’s mother was Agnes: Add “(1716/17–?), daughter of Robert Sanders (?–1755) and wife Rebeckath Groome, granddaughter of *James Saunders* (?–1707). Hester was the niece of *John Baldwin* (?–1752); and probably of Ann Sanders (ca. 1705–1785), who married *Darby Lux* (ca. 1698–1750). Her brothers were Sanders; James; and John. Her first cousins were Catherine Griffith (1732–1793), who married *Nicholas Worthington* (1734–1793); Anne Jennings (1745–1794), who married *Thomas Johnson* (1732–1819); Milcah Lusby (ca. 1721–1795), who married *John Matthews* (1714–1783); and probably *William Lux* (by 1730–1778) and *Darby Lux* (?–1795).”

CHASE, SAMUEL (1741–1811). **MARRIED** first, Ann’s mother was Agnes: Add “(1716/17–?), daughter of Robert Sanders (?–1755) and wife Rebeckath Groome, granddaughter of *James Saunders* (?–1707).
