

1 Assembly by the Governor shall then become law.

2 We have an addendum we would like to add.

3 However, I think it would be well if we vote on this part
4 first.

5 MRS. FREEDLANDER: Could we substitute the
6 word, reapportionment, instead of, redistricting?

7 DR. BARD: That is a good change.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: I am not so sure you can make
9 the change quite that simply. You are not going to re-
10 apportion.

11 DR. BARD: Reapportion and redistrict.

12 MR. SAYRE: That is why I think you have to have
13 the reapportionment and possible redistricting.

14 MR. SCANLAN: I am confused about that. The
15 way I understand the terms and why I agree with Mrs.
16 Freeland, reapportionment usually refers to changing
17 the representation in the State Legislature whereas re-
18 districting has usually been construed to mean changes in
19 the congressional districts of a State, but I concede
20 the words have been used interchangeably, and redistrict-
21 ing sometimes has been used generally to cover both, and
