2 THE CHAIRMAN: I don't think that is his point,
3 Professor Asper. I think, if I am following him, that
4 juvenile in a juvenile proceeding is not a person
5 accused of crime.

6 MRS. BOTHE: That is right.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: I think his question is whether
8 you are purposely using the phrase, Any person accused of
9 crime, so as to exclude from this Section the juvenile.

10 MR. BOND: No, sir, you are right.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: I take it that the Committee
12 was deliberately confining itself to criminal matters
13 in this Section.

14 MRS. BOTHE: Could I ask for an answer to my
15 question as to whether this phrase intended that everyone
16 would be entitled, regardless? Would you construe it
17 that way?

18 PROFESSOR ASPER: No, I wouldn't construe it
19 that way, and I don't see how it would be stated any
20 other way without writing a code of criminal procedure.

21 THE CHAIRMAN: Even then, you couldn't do it,
