

1 MR. MARTINEAU: We are not covering that.

2 JUDGE ADKINS: Why?

3 MR. MARTINEAU: We are not covering that
4 situation. That is going to have to be covered in the
5 schedule. In other words, we are not freezing anybody
6 in.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: I think you better tell him
8 first that the reason his statement wouldn't be correct
9 is that the Constitution will die with the adoption of
10 the new one so all protection on existing salaries is
11 gone.

12 JUDGE ADKINS: That is not my point, Mr.
13 Chairman. Immediately after the adoption.

14 MR. MARTINEAU: Immediately after the
15 adoption the Legislature will have to pass a law to say
16 what the Judges will see.

17 JUDGE ADKINS: Immediately after the
18 adoption of the new Constitution.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: All protection for Judges'
20 salaries is gone and it is not possible to have any
21 supplementation.
