would hesitate to be as stringent about it as I am, if it 1 were not for the fact that the task is tremendously impor-2 tant and we cannot do it with part of the Commission. We 3 need the help of every Member. 4 Is there anything anyone else desires to bring 5 up? May I ask just one other thing, before you leave, of 6 every Committee Chairman. I have a little hesitancy in 7 asking this, but not too much, really, because I have no 8 alternative. Will each Chairman ask his reporter to go 9 over the changes in the portions of the Constitution for 10 which the Committee is responsible and which have been agreed 11 upon finally and endeavor to let me have a draft, a com-12 pletely revised draft of what he understands to be com-13 pletely revised, except as to sections still under study, 14 by Tuesday. This would mean that each reporter, this is 15 a mechanical task, really, it means each reporter will have 16 to do it tomorrow or tomorrow evening. I don't care how 17 scratched up it is, but I think it's imperative that we 18 be able to submit to you in advance of the next meeting a 19 picture of the whole Constitution to the extent that we 20 have moved today. 21
