2 matters. I think it's rough that we have to do this, but
3 I really feel that it would be most unwise to provide at
4 this late date for absentee voting. You never know what
5 comes up in debate.

6 MR. MARTINEAU: Mr. Chairman, may I suggest that
7 if you don't permit them to vote, that I think the record
8 ought to indicate the feelings of those people who are ab-
9 sent?

10 THE CHAIRMAN: No difficulty about doing this at
11 all.

12 MR. BOND: May I suggest that the convening time
13 not be set at 9 o'clock next Monday morning?

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Would 8:30 be better?

15 MR. BOND: I just suspect it's going to be pretty
16 hard for everybody to get there by 9.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: It's up around Elkton. We'll
18 have to find out how far it is for the furthest Member and
19 work a convenient time. We'll try to work it so no one
20 has to arise earlier than 5 a.m. that morning.
