

1 received responses and I am sure that is the case, but
2 on the other hand from a public relations standpoint,
3 we should handle such letters either personally or the
4 Staff would, so if you can't handle the letters, we are
5 in a position to try to send some information to students
6 if you get requests.

7 MR. SYKES: If the Staff might be interested,
8 I handled the letter by taking the University of Maryland
9 Extension Service bulletin and saying, I am in favor of
10 the Convention for those reasons, and even though I might
11 have voted contrary to certain specific provisions,
12 in the final version, I am wholeheartedly in support of
13 the whole version.

14 MR. BROOKS: That is a good point, and if others
15 & you want some of these brochures, then we will send
16 you copies to answer such correspondence with.
