8 DR. TEMPLETON: I am afraid of a lot of  
9 things here.

10 DR. JENKINS: I am not.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Let me ask a question,  
12 Professor. You made reference a moment ago that the  
13 previous action would cut away from Section 3. I don't  
14 know what section you are referring to.

15 PROFESSOR ASPER: Section 3 is the section  
16 providing that residents on Federal Government reserva-  
17 tions -- what we said here was in national or state  
18 elections. It seems to me that if we now put something  
19 in Section 7, and at the moment I don't know what it is  
20 which says that you cannot have the limitations on any  
21 elections, that that cancels out the limitation of the
