

1 the word continuing, rather than continuous, and this may  
2 be a better word. Maybe this is what we ought to use.  
3 We are not wedded to that phrase. Indeed, if you believe  
4 that we can accomplish the goals that we seek without  
5 using the phrase at all, this is an order to recommend to  
6 us, but we do think we are virtually doing what we are  
7 recommending now, except we are causing a good deal of  
8 difficulty by going back to the electorate in terms of  
9 constitutional amendments every few years.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Miller?

11 MR. MILLER: Mr. Chairman, I thought we debated  
12 this pretty fully. Of course, there is another concept  
13 behind it, in addition to what has been said. We are  
14 trying to make a strong Legislature, and it isn't a  
15 strong Legislature if they have to go home five days  
16 before they want to. I thought we had debated all of these  
17 points and that our subcommittee was carrying out the  
18 will of the majority of the Commission when we reported it  
19 this way.
