

1 THE CHAIRMAN: I doubt that would be as
2 readily available to us in September, but it may be.
3 In any event, will you please give very serious considera-
4 tion and believe me honestly, when I say it is with
5 considerable trepidation when I ask you to again consider
6 a two-day session in August, but I think we are faced
7 with the situation that we simply cannot conclude our
8 work unless we do have a two-day session, and I would
9 like this afternoon before we adjourn to take a few
10 minutes to discuss it and find out generally from you
11 if we have a two-day session, whether you like what we
12 did this time, Sunday and Monday, with the promise of
13 perhaps a little more to be lived up to as to the hour
14 of adjournment on Sunday evening, or whether you would
15 have perhaps two other days.

16 Let me also remind you that your checking out
17 of the hotel here is a simple process. You don't have
18 to pay the bill. You just turn in your key, but most of
19 us should get out of our rooms between now and 1 o'clock
20 so that the hotel can have the room.
