

ALLEGANY COUNTY—Resolutions of public meeting of citizens of District No. 15, 75.

A bill to authorize Francis Mattingley to erect gates upon a road passing near his house to the Catholic Church, near Mount Savage, 161, 169, 175.

An act to authorize the Commissioners to pay George L. Layman for certain services rendered as constable, 233, 270.

An act to ratify the proceedings of the Circuit Court of Allegany county as a Court of Equity, appointing William Walsh, Trustee, to complete the collection of State and County taxes for the years 1860 and 1861, and perform other duties of Collector, in place of John Callan, late Collector, deceased, 316, 317, 318.

BANKS—Leave granted to report a bill to amend nineteenth section of article of the Code of Public General Laws relating to Banks, 11, 12.

Relative to payment of specie, 20, 21, 37, 38.

That no banks shall issue or pay out notes of less denomination than one dollar, to an amount greater than ten per cent. on their capital actually paid in, and that the issue is to expire sixty days after the session of 1864, 24.
