SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Commissioner of Labor and Industry ~~shall adopt regulations for training in the safe use operation of power equipment by January 1, 1991 and shall prepare for general use a model training program with minimum standards for employee training in the safe use operation of power equipment by April 1, 1991, in consultation with the Advisory Committee on Safety Training Programs for Power Equipment Operators, shall adopt regulations consistent with § 33A(d) of this Act by April 1, 1991.~~

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, ~~except as provided in Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall take effect on June 1, 1991~~ January 1, 1992 § 33A(d) and (f) of this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the penalty provisions of Article 89, § 40 of the Code shall not apply to this Act until April 1, 1993.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as provided in Sections 2, 3, and 4 of this Act, this Act shall take effect April 1, 1992.

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of ~~\$3,500,000~~ ~~\$1,000,000~~ \$500,000 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the County Executive and County Council of Baltimore County and the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for the repair, renovation, restoration, and structural and nonstructural improvements to the Lake Roland Dam in Baltimore County, subject to the requirement that the County Executive and County Council of Baltimore County and the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, as equal participants, provide at least an equal and matching fund of a certain kind for the
