AN ACT concerning

Title 13. "Health and Sanitation"

FOR the purpose of repealing sections providing for duties of police officers to execute orders, public hospitals, regulations for pigpens and hogpens, disposition of carcasses, limitation on sale of pasteurized milk, authority to make regulations, appointment of inspectors and analysts, meetings of the board of health, notice to abate nuisances, procedure of abatement, proceedings in equity, effect on general public law, discharge of liquids, zoning approval of camps, compliance with fire laws, Department of Public Works requirements, display of license, compliance with Plumbing Code, prohibition of cesspools and septic tanks, location of sewage disposal systems, waste water disposal, declaration of policy, authority to amend or repeal rules and regulations, orders to cease violations, appeals, supplemental and additional provisions, injunctive relief for air pollution, time for existing marinas to comply, extension of time, review committee, its meetings, its duties, repeal of conflicting acts, severability clause; repealing and reenacting sections providing for duties of county health officer, organization of department of health, manner of keeping animals, authority to adopt smoke control regulations, regulations governing food service facilities, powers of Board of Health, penalty for violating policies, penalty for obstructing personnel, nuisances generally, notice to abate nuisances, procedure for abatement, possession of dead or injured animals, employment of people for trash collection, collection of refuse, storage or dumping of offensive material, spreading manure, licensing of camps, application to
