(C) (1) THE STUDENT MEMBER SHALL HAVE A TERM OF 1 YEAR BEGINNING JUNE 1 AND ENDING ON MAY 30.

~~(2) EXCEPT FOR THE STUDENT MEMBER, THE TERM IS 6 YEARS FROM JUNE 1 OF THE YEAR THE APPOINTMENT IS MADE AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES. THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED, AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ON JANUARY 1, 1990 FROM JUNE 1, 1990 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1993.~~

(3) A MEMBER APPOINTED TO FILL A VACANCY IN AN UNEXPIRED TERM SERVES ONLY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THAT TERM AND OR UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(D) EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

(1) SERVES WITHOUT COMPENSATION; AND

(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS.

~~(E) (1) THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL BE APPOINTED ANNUALLY BY THE GOVERNOR.~~

~~(2) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY ELECT ANY OTHER OFFICERS IT REQUIRES.~~

(E) EACH YEAR THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

(1) SHALL ELECT ONE OF ITS NONSTUDENT MEMBERS AS ITS CHAIRMAN; AND

(2) MAY ELECT ANY OTHER OFFICERS IT REQUIRES.

(F) (1) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL MEET REGULARLY AT SUCH TIMES AND PLACES AS IT DETERMINES.

(2) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY ADOPT RULES FOR THE CONDUCT OF ITS MEETINGS AND THE TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS.

(H) (G) A MAJORITY OF THE VOTING MEMBERS SHALL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM FOR THE TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS.
