

For the entry of judgment thereon, or on submission or confession,	25 cts.
For issuing every warrant or writ for the execution of a judgment or sentence of the court,	20 cts.
For issuing a bench warrant, <i>capias ad respondendum</i> , or other process to apprehend a criminal, either before or after verdict and judgment,	20 cts.
For entering the commitment or releasement of any criminal, or other person, by order of the court,	10 cts.
For the docket entry of a <i>nolle prosequi</i> , or pardon, or the determination of any criminal case or prosecution, when the same may have been quashed, or otherwise finally ended,	5 cts.
For the docket entry, when an indictment or information may have been returned by a grand jury "a true bill," "not a true bill," "ignoramus," or otherwise,	5 cts.
For issuing subpoena <i>ad testificandum</i> , including the name of all the witnesses applied for at the same time, not exceeding three,	10 cts.
And for each person exceeding that number in addition thereto,	2 cts.
For issuing an attachment for contempt, filing, entering return thereof, and the court's judgment or decision thereon, whether the party be fined, discharged on payment of costs, or otherwise, including order and all other services in relation thereto,	62½ cts.
For issuing a writ of <i>duces tecum, ad respondendum</i> or <i>habeas corpus</i> ,	20 cts.
For issuing a <i>venire facias</i> to summon jurors or talesmen, by order of court,	10 cts.
For administering every oath or affirmation in court, others than jurors,	5 cts.
For drawing, empannelling and swearing a grand jury, and entry of the pannel thereof,	\$1 25
