Contains an interchange of correspondence between Gibson and Murray, including a reprinting of a handbill by Murray (item 665), in which Gibson is identified as "of the Senate of Maryland, and of Talbot county," and a handbill by Gibson dated Dec. 25, 1808 (item 628). The final piece in the leaflet is dated: Marengo, 8th January, 1809; Marengo was the name of Gibson's estate on the Eastern Shore.
