The number of visitors for the last three fiscal years is as follows:

Over half of our visitors came from the State of Maryland, the exact number being 630, the others came from thirty-four States, the District of Columbia and two foreign countries.

In spite of fewer visitors, the number of items circulated increased enough to exceed that of any other year with the exception of 1937-1938. And it should be noted that in the earlier years of our operations the number of items which had to be handled by visitors was exceedingly large due to the lack of general indexes.
