#### CHAPTER 251.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of Wm. J. C. Dulany Company for stationery furnished the State library, Court of Appeals, Executive Department and Legislative Department of the State of Maryland, from January 10, 1896, to March 17, 1896, inclusive.

Appropriation.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller be and he is hereby directed to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer in favor of William J. C. Dulany Company, for the sum of fourteen hundred and fifteen and twenty-nine one hundredth dollars, (\$1,415.29,) for stationery furnished the State library, Court of Appeals, Executive Department and Legislative Department of the State of Maryland, from January 10, 1896, to March 17, 1896.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 252.

AN ACT to prohibit the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer within half a mile of the Junction of Gittings Avenue and Belona Avenue in Baltimore County.
