

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby declared, given and granted to the conveyance from William B. Hill, trustee, to the vestry of Saint Peter's Church in the city of Baltimore, a corporation, a deed dated March 21, 1874, and recorded among the land records of Baltimore city in Liber G. R. No. 650, folio 366, etc., and that the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby likewise declared, given and granted to the conveyance from the said vestry of St. Peter's Church in the city of Baltimore, a corporation, to the vestry of Henshaw Memorial Church of Baltimore city, a corporation, by deed dated June 3, 1892, and recorded upon the land records of Baltimore city in Liber J. B. No. 1398, folio 137, etc.

SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland is hereby declared to be given and granted to the holding of the said lot of ground described particularly in the said conveyances mentioned in section 1 of this Act by the said vestry of St. Peter's Church in the city of Baltimore, a corporation, and the said vestry of Henshaw Memorial Church of Baltimore city, a corporation, during the time that the said lot of ground described in the conveyances aforesaid was held respectively by them, the said corporations, under and by virtue of said conveyances.

SEC. 3. *Be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 104.

AN ACT to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to certain bequests contained in the last will and testament of Louise S. Dallas, deceased.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given to the following bequests contained in the last will and testament of Louise S. Dallas, late of the city of Baltimore, deceased, bearing date the twenty-first day of March, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, and recorded in the office of the Register of Wills for Baltimore city, in Wills' Liber S. R. M. No. 87, folio 479, etc., to wit: A bequest to the Home of All Saints Sisters of the Poor of Baltimore City, a body corporate, of bond No. 1763, of the Atlanta and Charlotte Air Line Railway Company first mortgage bonds for one thousand dollars.
