Preamble WHEREAS, Under said claim of the State of Maryland the William Fait Company of Baltimore City erroneously paid to the State Treasurer the sum of six hundred and ninety-four dollars and twenty-three cents (\$694.23) since April 6, 1894; and

WHEREAS, Under said claim of the State of Maryland the John Boyle Company erroneously paid to the State Treasurer the sum of one hundred and twelve dollars and thirty-one cents (\$112.31) since April 6, 1894; and

WHEREAS, Under said claim of the State of Maryland the firm of H. J. McGrath and Company erroneously paid to the State Treasurer the sum of five dollars and seventy-three cents (\$5.73) since April 6, 1894; and

WHEREAS, Under said claim of the State of Maryland the firm of William H. Killiam erroneously paid to the State Treasurer the sum of three dollars (\$3) since April 6, 1894; and

WHEREAS, The Attorney-General of Maryland has declared that all of said tax collected since April 6, 1894, has been illegally collected.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sum of money hereinafter named be and they are hereby appropriated to and for the re-payment of said taxes collected, as aforesaid: To the firm of Thomas Kensett & Company the sum of two hundred and ninety-two dollars and twenty-two cents (\$292.22).
