- Woolford Nut:** in Dorchester County.
- Woolsford's Creek:** (creek) in Dorchester County; see Woolford Creek.
- Woolsford's Neck:** (neck) in Dorchester County; see Woolford Neck.
- Wootenau Creek:** (creek) in Talbot County; branch of Kings Creek, emptying into Choptank River (3) miles northeast of Easton. (N. 38°48' W. 76°02') ST.M.
- Worlds End Creek:** (creek) in Dorchester County; branch of Charles Creek, empties into Honga River, northeast of Wroten Island. (N. 38°22' W. 76°10') CRA
- Worthington Valley:** (valley) in Baltimore County; (1¼) miles northeast of Emory Grove; elev. 300. (N. 39°30' W. 76°46') ELL
- Worton:** (village) in Kent County; (1) mile southeast of Butlertown; elev. 25; pop. (165); P. O.; Penna. R.R.; Md. 297; Western Union. (N. 39°16' W. 76°05') BET
- Worton Creek:** (creek) in Kent County; branch of Chesapeake Bay, mouth (3) miles north of Melitota. (N. 39°17' W. 76°10') BET
- Worton Point:** (point) in Kent County; projecting into Chesapeake Bay, (2) miles northwest of Newtown. (N. 39°19' W. 76°11') BET
- Woytych:** (village) in Anne Arundel County; (½) mile southeast of Iglehart; elev. 125; Md. 178. (N. 39°01' W. 76°34') REL
- Wright:** (village) in Dorchester County; see Wright Wharf.
- Wright Creek:** (creek) in Harford County; branch of Gunpowder River, mouth (¾) mile south of Fort Hoyle, (2½) miles southeast of Magnolia (village). (N. 39°22' W. 76°18') GUN
- Wright Neck:** (neck) in Queen Anne's County; narrow strip of land between Reed Creek and Grove Creek, (2½) miles northwest of Brownsville; elev. (20). (N. 39°03' W. 76°10') CHE
- Wright School:** (village) in Dorchester County; (2) miles north of Cokesbury School; elev. 42. (N. 38°39' W. 75°44') SEA
- Wright Wharf:** (landing) in Dorchester County at mouth of Choptank River; (3) miles southwest of Beulah; elev. 5. (N. 38°40' W. 75°57') HUR
- Wrights:** in Caroline County.
- Wrights:** (village) in Dorchester County; (2) miles south of Hills Point; elev. 3; pop. (12). (N. 38°40' W. 76°15') OXF
- Wrights Branch:** (branch) in Dorchester County; mouth at Marshyhope Creek, (1½) miles east of Ennalls. (N. 38°37' W. 75°50') HUR
- Wrights Crossing:** in Allegany County.
- Wrights Pond:** (pond) in Dorchester County; drained by Gales Creek, at mouth of Nanticoke River, (3½) miles northeast of Eldorado. (N. 38°37' W. 75°44') SEA
- Wrights Run:** (run) in Allegany County; branch of Georges Creek, mouth in Carlos Junction; elev. (1,720); Md. 36. (N. 39°36' W. 78°57') FROST
- Wrights Wharf:** (village) in Dorchester County; see Wright Wharf.
- Wrightson:** in Baltimore County.
- Wroten Island:** (island) in Dorchester County; in Honga River, (2) miles east of Upper Hooper Island. (N. 38°19' W. 76°11') CRA
- Wroths Point:** (point) in Cecil County; projecting into the Elk River, (1) mile north of Pond Neck; elev. (20). (N. 39°26' W. 75°59') CEC
- Wroten Island:** (island) in Dorchester County; see Wroten Island.
- Wye East River:** (river) in Queen Anne's and Talbot Counties; branch of Wye River, mouth at southwestern extremity of Wye Island; on county boundary line. (N. 38°53' W. 76°06') ST.M.
- Wye Heights:** in Talbot County.
- Wye Island:** (island) in Queen Anne's County; island in Wye River, (2½) miles south of Wye Neck; elev. (10). (N. 38°54' W. 76°10') ST.M.
- Wye Landing:** (landing) in Talbot County; on Wye East River, (3½) miles southwest of Wye Mills; elev. 5. (N. 38°54' W. 76°05') ST.M.
- Wye Mills:** (village) in Queen Anne's and Talbot Counties; (3) miles northwest of Willoughby; elev. 22; pop. (175); P. O.; B. & E. R.R.; U. S. 213; Md. 404; Western Union. (N. 38°57' W. 76°05') ST.M.
